Custodial History:

The album was donated to the Hudson's Bay Company by J.G.M.Christie. The album was received at the archives from Hudson's Bay House Library (then designated Album 12). The accession number is 1986/35.

Scope and Content:

An album of 16 photographs sent by W.C. Rackham to J.G.M. Christie documenting a trip in Manitoba, along the Burntwood River, and into the Peace River area. Rackham and Christie were likely to have travelled together when working in the administration of the Fur Trade Dept., ca.1915-1920. Christie used the album to paste in a few personal and family photographs.
